

## **Workshop Internasional FK UB**

Selama dua hari, Kamis-Jumat (26-27/1) Fakultas Kedokteran Universitas Brawijaya (FK UB) bekerjasama dengan St George's University of London menyelenggarakan Workshop Internasional bertemakan "Developing A Clinical Rotation And Internship Management System To Achieve Global Competency" yang dipusatkan di Gedung Graha Medika Lantai 2. Acara dibuka secara langsung oleh Dekan FK UB Dr. dr. Karyono Mintaroem, SpPA.

Sebelum memulai seminar, terlebih dahulu dilakukan penandatanganan Piagam Kesepahaman Bersama (MoU) antara FK UB dengan St George's University of London.

FK UB diwakili langsung oleh Dekan Dr. dr. Karyono Mintaroem, SpPA sedangkan dari St George's University of London diwakili oleh Prof. Sean Hilton selaku Direktur Hubungan Internasional. Dalam MoU tersebut kedua belah pihak menyepakati beberapa hal diantaranya adalah kolaborasi penelitian, pertukaran mahasiswa, standarisasi kurikulum pendidikan dokter, penelitian di bidang biomedik, dan program dual degree.

Pada acara workshop hadir sebagai pemateri Ketua Komite Internsip Dokter Indonesia, Prof. Dr. Mulyohadi Ali, dr, Sp.FK memaparkan tentang Program Internsip Kedokteran Indonesia.

Internship merupakan suatu program magang bagi dokter yang baru menyelesaikan masa pendidikan profesi, dengan tujuan meningkatkan kesempatan untuk mengaplikasikan pengetahuan, keterampilan, dan sikap yang diperoleh selama pendidikan.

"Diharapkan dengan adanya internship bisa menghasilkan dokter yang profesional, mandiri dan ahli di bidangnya masing-masing," ungkapnya.

Lebih lanjut Prof. Mulyohadi menyampaikan kegiatan intrenship ini merupakan program yang dinamis dan perlu evaluasi berkelanjutan serta menjalin kolaborasi dengan pihak-pihak terkait untuk mengembangkan program ini agar bisa lebih baik lagi.

Sedangkan Prof. Sean Hilton memaparkan tentang Profesionalisme Pengajaran dan Pembelajaran dalam Pendidikan Kedokteran. Prof. Sean menyampaikan seorang dokter profesional adalah seseorang yang melakukan tugasnya dengan benar pada waktu yang tepat, untuk alasan yang benar bahkan ketika tidak ada seorangpun yang melihat pekerjaannya.

"Profesionalisme seorang dokter tercermin melalui perilaku sehingga kepercayaan publik terhadap seorang dokter akan meningkat," ungkapnya.

Prof. Sean juga menyampaikan sikap profesionalisme juga bisa dilihat dengan enam indikator yaitu menghargai pasien, menjunjung etika praktek, bertanggungjawab pada setiap tindakan, bekerja dengan tim, mempunyai tanggungjawab sosial, dan mempunyai kesadaran tinggi.

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## **International Workshop in FK UB**

For two days (26-27/1), School of Medicine Universitas Brawijaya (FK UB) in collaboration with St. George's University of London held an International Workshop entitled "Developing a Clinical Rotation and Internship Management System to Achieve Global Competency" which was located in 2nd Floor of Graha Medika. The event was opened directly by the Dean of UB's School of Medicine, Dr. dr. Karyono Mintaroem, SpPA.

Before the seminar was began, there was a signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between FK UB and St. George's University of London.

FK UB was represented by the Dean, Dr. dr. Karyono Mintaroem, SpPA while from St. George's University of London was represented by Prof. Sean Hilton as the Director of International Relations. In MoU, both parties agree on several things including the collaborative research, student exchange, curriculum standardization of physician education, research in biomedical, and dual degree program.

At the workshop, present as the speaker, the Chairman of Internship Committee of Indonesia Physicians, Prof. Dr. Mulyohadi Ali, dr, Sp.FK elaborated about the Program of Indonesia Physician Internship.

Internship is an a program for new physicians who just have completed profession education, with the purpose to increase the opportunities to apply their knowledge, skills and attitudes acquired during education.

"Hopefully, with internship, it can produce physicians who are professional, independent and expert in their respective fields," he said.

Furthermore, Prof. Mulyohadi conveyed that intrenship was a dynamic program and needed ongoing evaluation and established collaboration with relevant parties to develop this program to get better.

Meanwhile, Prof. Sean Hilton explained the professionalism of Teaching and Learning in Medical Education. Prof. Sean stated that a medical professional was someone who did his/her job correctly at the right time, for the right reasons and even when no one has seen his/her work.

"Professionalism of a physician is reflected through his/her's behavior so that public trust to a physician will increase," he said.

Prof. Sean also conveyed an attitude of professionalism could also be seen with six indicators, they were patient respect, uphold ethical practices, responsible for every action, working with a team, has a social responsibility, and has a high awareness.
